# **Terms & Conditions**

#### 1. Who can Enter

- 1.1. To be eligible to enter the prize draw, participants must:
- 1.1.1. be aged 18 or over; and

### 2. Entry Period

## 3. Entry

- 3.1. Eligible participants will automatically be entered into the draw provided their policy is still in force at least 21 days after its start date.
- 3.2. The Promoter reserves the right at its absolute discretion to disqualify entries which it considers do not comply with these Terms and Conditions, any participant who it reasonably believes has interfered with the fair running of this prize draw, any participant that has provided inaccurate or incomplete information when purchasing their insurance policy and any participant that has failed to pay premium when due.
- 3.3. The Promoter shall have the right, where necessary, to undertake all such action as is reasonable to protect itself against fraudulent or invalid entries including, without limitation, to require further verification as to the identity, age, and other relevant details of a participant.

#### 4. Prize

- 4.1. There will be five winners who will be selected within 7 days of the closing date of the prize draw. Each winner will receive a pair of tickets to the Goodwood Revival. We will endeavour to allocate tickets on the day of each winners' first choice, but this might not always be possible due to ticket availability.
- 4.2. The winners shall be selected in accordance with Clause 6.
- 4.11. The prize is as described, it is non-negotiable and non-transferable. The prize cannot be exchanged for any alternative option.
- 4.12. The winners will be contacted by email within of the prize draw closing.
- 4.13. The Promoter will attempt to contact the winner up to four times over a period of 7 days. If the winner does not respond, the Promoter may select a new

winner from a list of reserves drawn at the original time.

4.14. The winner may decline their prize.

## 5. Data Protection and Publicity

- 5.1. Any personal data relating to participants will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation. The Promoter shall seek consent from the winners in order to do the following:
- 5.1.1. promote/announce the winners on the Promoter's social media channels (y using the winners' names and, if possible, tagging in the winners' social media profiles; and/or
- 5.1.2. in accordance with clause 6.2, provide details of the winners to those who request them; and/or
- 5.1.3. request testimonial comments from the winners for the Promoter to use for marketing purposes.
- 5.2. The Promoter will process participants' personal data in accordance with its Privacy Notice

## 6. Selecting Winners

- 6.1. The winners of the prize draw (who will be chosen from eligible entries) will be randomly selected by a computerised randomiser.
- 6.2. Subject to clause 5.1.2, the last name and county of the winners will be available on request to those sending a stamped, addressed envelope marked Revival Tickets Prize Draw within 3 months of the closing date.
